

Briefing for Wickham Market Parish Council

Proposed location of three new litter bins. Agenda Item: FC23:80

1. Background

- 1.1. Litter in Wickham Market is a recurring problem, both general litter and dog waste.
- 1.2. Where litter bins are installed, they are generally well used but there are some areas that currently have inadequate facilities.

2. Location

- 2.1. In addition to the relocation of the previously vandalised bin by the Multi Use Games arena, there have been three other requests for bin installation. These are:
 - 2.1.1. A dog waste bin at the bottom of Broad Road
 - 2.1.2. A general litter bin between the village hall and the football club
 - 2.1.3. A general litter and dog waste bin on the road to the white bridges path (just east of the A12 tunnel)
 - 2.1.4. See locations  on map attached .

3. East Suffolk Services view

- 3.1. Having contacted East Suffolk Services [ESSL] (Laura Hack) their views are as follows:
 - 3.1.1. Broad Road: Install a general waste bin with a notice to accept bagged dog waste.
 - 3.1.2. Football Club: ESSL do not think this is necessary. However, it is a youth meeting point which generates lots of litter (you've probably seen it!). So, I have asked Laura to reconsider.
 - 3.1.3. White Bridges: ESSL suggest a dog waste bin to the east of the A12 tunnel. However, there are complaints of general litter, so I have asked for a general waste bin with a notice to accept bagged dog waste.

4. Cost to WMPC

- 4.1. Cost to WMPC is currently not known, if any. Still awaiting confirmation from ESSL

5. Recommendation

- 5.1. WMPC to approve location of three new bind as described in 3 above.
