1. Wickham Market News: Deadline for April Issue was 14 March.

2. Website

- 2.1. The project for a new village website has officially started and funding of £3,500 is in place towards the £6.8k build cost. Delivery is expected in late Spring 2025
- 2.2. PC Website moving to a new domain wickhammarket-pc.gov.uk

3. Emails

- 3.1. New .gov.uk emails to go live from 18 March
 - Your emails will be transferred to a new account together with your email history.
 - · Once this is done you will not have access to your old account
 - An auto forward will be put in place for two months from the date of transfer.
 - After this period incoming emails will not be accepted to your old account and it will be deleted

4. Children's play area

4.1. Still awaiting skate park repair quotes

5. Markets

- 5.1. The Spring market on 29 March is fully booked with 40 stalls which will include food and drink vendors
- 5.2. I challenged a £150 cost to close the road. This has now been withdrawn

6. Insurance and Volunteers

- 6.1. Work is ongoing to create appropriate risk assessments and records to ensure volunteers are insured while working on pre agreed council activities.
- 6.2. The initial documents are presented for approval at item 162

7. Bank Mandate

- 7.1. Electronic Access still needs to be created by Gloria and Gemma
- 7.2. CCLA account has been opened with £60k

8. Litter Picking and Maintenance

9. Cemetery

9.1. Work to level graves to facilitate easier cutting has been completed

10. Leases

10.1. The original licenses to occupy for the Bowls Club and the Football Club expired in February 1998. Both organisations will be approached to agree heads of terms for a new lease. Birketts solicitors in Ipswich expect the cost to be £1,500 providing this process goes smoothly.

11. Grass Cutting 2025

- 11.1. Grass cutting requirements for 2025 have been defined and a quote is awaited from ESSL
- 11.2. 17/3 Just received. ESSL costs have increased by just under 6% in general. In brief summary:
 - Playing field grass cutting has increased by £1.2k due to increased frequency over last year
 - The Pightle and Cemetery ditch and soil compound maintenance remain similar
 - Cemetery Lime Trees has increased by £1.4k as they are due their periodic pollarding in 2025
 - Cemetery grass cutting has reduced from £5.7 to £2.2k as a direct result of the structural works which cost £1.6k. After taking into account price increases of 6% this is a saving of £3.8k per year which makes the cemetery more sustainable going forwards.

12. Footpath Maintenance 2025

12.2. ESSL have been asked to quote for footpath maintenance for Little Lane and FP009 (George to Spring Lane) other quotes are also being sought from local providers.
