Environment and Leisure committee Report

Warm Rooms. It was agreed to apply for a grant of £2,860 from East Suffolk, which was subsequently approved

Allotments: there were a number of smaller issues which are being address together with a larger issue regarding the overgrown Hazel trees on Glebe plot 39 which will require more attention.

Christmas decorations on the Hill. The following purchases were agreed

- Christmas Trees with trunks milled to fit holders plus large tree
- Battery lights for the small trees to a total value of up to £500 – Now purchased for £179.70
- Plane Tree light replacements which will require quotes. A total figure of £2,200 was pre authorised. Current expected cost is c£1,700

Chapel Lane: It was agreed that “Unsuitable for HGVs” signage should be added to the quiet Lanes post which will be requested as a taller post to accommodate both signs

Cemetery:

- Winter tree work has been identified and requires costing
- The seat in the old garden of remembrance requires refurbishment. Men’s Shed to be asked and have subsequently agreed to do this
- Cemetery regulations were reviewed and some minor amendments suggested. A Cemetery plan will be required for the finished document

Village Hall Playing Field: It was agreed that the grass and debris along under the bowls club hedge be removed and that the bowls club manage their green waste. Ivor to request a contribution for the cost of removal from the Bowls Club
